Dr. Sudip Shrestha



Dr. Sudip Shrestha, the Executive Chairman of Nepal Cancer Hospital and Research Center (NCHRC) is a visionary and a pioneer in the field of oncology in Nepal. His “dream project” of a comprehensive cancer hospital in Nepal that provided quality cancer care was realized in 2015, when NCHRC was established under his leadership as Executive Chairman. Before NCHRC, Dr. Shrestha worked as Medical Director and HOD of Bhaktapur Cancer Hospital, helping establish and run this important public hospital, and also played an instrumental role in establishing the Om Cancer Care Centre, the dedicated cancer care wing of a popular private hospital in Nepal. His passion for comprehensive cancer care has led him to envision and set up many organizations dedicated to academic, palliative or other aspects.

Annex B

Dr Jeremy B Ward



Jeremy B Ward MB ChB, MD, FRCSEd (Gen Surg) is a consultant Upper Gastro-intestinal and General Surgeon at Lancashire Teaching Hospitals and is Chairman of Health Exchange Nepal (HEXN-UK).

He has been a consultant surgeon since 2002 specialising in oesophago-gastric cancer, biliary and emergency surgery. He led the centralisation of oesophago-gastric cancer services in the Lancashire and S Cumbria Cancer Network.

He has a special interest in clinical training at all levels. With a special interest in Human Factors he is a faculty member on NOTSS (non-technical skills for surgeons) courses run by the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh throughout the UK. He has developed multi-disciplinary Safe Surgery workshops to promote safe practices within his own Trust and taught on Human Factors Courses for multi-disciplinary Obstetric teams as part of the “Better Training Better Births” initiative at a regional level.

He has been Chairman of HEXN since 2008. HEXN has supported numerous health education projects during that time. Over the last 6 years he has been personally directly involved in co-ordinating laparoscopic surgery and non-technical skills training courses for surgeons in Nepal. The charity also supported earthquake relief efforts in 2015 and the rebuilding of 2 schools in the Gorkha region.

Jeremy is an examiner for the MRCS and FRCS examinations and recently joined the Joint Collegiate Board of Examinations for General Surgery.
